Help with Energy Bills for Businesses - Energy Bill Relief Scheme

The Government's Energy Bill Relief Scheme (EBRS) will cut energy prices for non-domestic energy customers such as businesses and charities. The scheme will apply to fixed contracts agreed on or after 1.4.22 as well as to variable and flexible tariffs and contracts. Discounts will apply to energy usage initially between 1.10.22 and 31.3.23. No action is needed to access the scheme - suppliers will automatically apply the EBRS discount to the energy bill. From 1 November 2022, VAT-registered businesses must use Making Tax Digital (MTD) compatible software for their VAT returns. Businesses that file their VAT returns on a quarterly or monthly basis will no longer be able to submit them using their existing VAT online account, unless HMRC has agreed they are exempt from MTD. 




